Charlotte Helen Bullock, a lifelong resident of Texas, passed away at 10:41 a.m. on Monday, December 21, 2020, at the age of 74. Charlotte is survived by her two children, Earl Ryburn, Jr. and Tana Brady; her daughter-in-law and son-in-law, Michelle Ryburn and Patrick Brady; and her three grandchildren, Sarah, Katie, and Caraline. She is predeceased by her husband, Bill Bullock; and her parents, John and Elnora Coe. Charlotte was born in Texas on September 22, 1946. She received her nurse certification in 1970 and primarily helped patients in hospice care.

Charlotte was the daughter of devout church ministers, a devoted mother, and a loving grandmother. Her interests included traveling and helping others through community service. As a child, she lived in Alaska, which was dear to her heart. Charlotte's door was always open to those in need. Charlotte and her late husband, Bill, opened up their home as a Veterans' Residential Care Home for senior veterans of foreign war. She often worked with church food pantries in her community to help feed the hungry. Charlotte was known as a hard worker, she would use her funds to advance the lives of others. Most importantly, she was a woman who loved the Lord. She found a beautiful spiritual community at St. Sophia Greek Orthodox Church. Charlotte held her church family in her heart. She loved God and from the day she walked into St. Sophia, she said that she knew she had found her home. Charlotte and her son, Earl, joined the church together and were baptized and Chrismated on the same day, as Eleni (Helen) and Constantinos. She immensely enjoyed being part of the community and helped, as she could, at the Greek Funstivals. Those who knew her described her as a "joy to be around." She will be dearly missed by her family, friends, coworkers, and all who knew her joyful spirit. Charlotte will continue to be a shining example of selfless service and servant leadership. May her memory be eternal!

A funeral service is scheduled for December 29, 2020, at St. Sophia's Greek Orthodox Church.
