Timothy Clive Hollis went to be with his Lord on Friday June 11, 2021. Born in Springfield, Massachusetts, on September 5, 1977, Tim was the beloved son of Frederick Scott Hollis (Lt. Col USAF, Ret.) and Linda Morrell Hollis. He graduated Churchill High and later ITT Technical Institute where he earned an Associate of Applied Science Degree. Tim enlisted in the United States Air Force Reserve in 1996. He served his country faithfully for 15 years and reached the rank of Technical Sergeant before being medically retired in 2012. It was a great source of pride to all that Tim was both sworn into and retired from the Air Force by his father.

Tim was a loving son, brother, uncle, nephew, cousin and a stellar friend. He had a wide array of interests and a talent for learning and mentoring others. He particularly enjoyed cooking and being with his friends and family.
