Abel Alonzo went to be with the Lord on October 4, 2016, leaving behind friends and family. He was born in San Antonio, Texas where he grew up and raised a family. He graduated from Fox Tech H.S. in 1955. After learning an electrical trade, he worked as an electrician for a few companies before achieving a Master Electrician's License which he used to start his own company. He joined the San Antonio Fire Department in 1965, rising to the rank of engineer, and also became a Paramedic in the 3rd EMS Class of the newly formed Division. He loved helping others in their most difficult times. His ability to calm both patients and new paramedics was a trait he was remembered for by many. His belief in the Bible remained a constant throughout his life and he never failed to share it with others. He recognized that life was an adventure, and mistakes were inevitable.
