



## Abigail Sebring Sinko

July 25, 1926 - July 11, 2017

Abigail Sebring Sinko, 90, died of cancer July 11, 2017 at home with sons Mark and David, daughter-in-law Lois, and friend Maryann Aguilar. She was one of a kind, with style, grace and a sense of humor that endeared her to everyone who knew her.

Born in Sebring, Ohio July 25, 1926, she grew up with a broad range of influences and deep connections with many loving people. Abbie married George E.
