Adam G. Rodriguez died on Saturday, October 26, 2013, at 89. He was born on June 22, 1924, to Guadalupe and Maria in San Antonio. He proved adept at aircraft mechanics as a 17-year old student. This education was put aside when he joined the Army Air Corp in World War II. After the war he resumed working on all aspects of the flying machines. Ultimately, he became a flight engineer for Air Force Reserve flight crews at Kelly Air Force Base, traveling to South America, Europe and Asia. But, his travels began when the war took him to India as a 19 year old who had never ventured far beyond the San Antonio city limits of the 1930's. All of these travels made for rich story-telling, as much as his tales of growing up at a time when a 16-year old delivery boy was paid in cash and cigarettes, certain bartenders would look the other way when serving minors and a young man could walk across town in the wee hours after visiting the girl who would become his wife. It was these tales that told us who he was, how he got where he was and how much an inquiring mind and a sense of wonder had enriched a life born in humble circumstances. Adam's wife, Josephine, predeceased him. He is survived by his younger brother Noe Rodriguez; his daughter Yvonne Siber Sam, and their sons, Christopher Lisa and Jason, and great-grandson, James; and his son, Michael A. Rodriguez Toni and their children Sarah and Matthew.
