She had six grandchildren and three great-grandchildren. She lived most of her life in Puebla, Mexico. She came to the United States twenty years ago and lived in Houston where she made many friends.

When Adelita came to San Antonio in 2000 she immediately started to make friends. She would go shopping alone, not speaking English, and always found her "Angelitos," who spoke Spanish, to help her. In 2003, she became a Volunteer at University Hospital. She used her skill at crocheting to make special buntings to fit the tiny babies who were lost early in pregnancy. The parents were grateful to have this remembrance of the baby they lost. During her 15 years that she was a volunteer, she made hundreds of these buntings. She also worked for years in the Mailroom and had friends all over the hospital. Just before she became homebound in October, she received her 15-Year Volunteer Award from the CEO of University Hospital at a breakfast in her honor. She was very proud of her work at University Hospital. She knew everyone, and they loved her. She was also proud of becoming an American Citizen in 2014 and voted in every election when she was well.

She was always an elegant lady, greeting people with a smile. She was always ready to help and pray for old friends and new. She is now with her Lord and surrounded by the many angels that guided her life. We thank Vicky Enciso and Luis Villareal for caring for and helping her. She will be missed by her family and friends in both Mexico and the United States.
