Adelaida Robles Jimenez was born July 26, 1925 in San Antonio, Texas and died May 27, 2015 in Phoenix, Arizona. She lived the first 75 years of her life in San Antonio, Texas.

Robert Jimenez after her husband passed away. In earlier years she was the office manager for her husband's company, Frank's Signs.
