Adolph Schmidt of China Groove, Texas entered eternal life on June 23, 2009 at the age of 84. He was born January 24, 1925 in the Poth farming community, Wilson County, to Charlie and Maria Schmidt. He served in the 44th Infantry Division during World War II which saw action in Europe and returned to the San Antonio area where he worked his entire life as an automobile mechanic. He was constantly active and lived life to its fullest be it trotline fishing on local rivers for large flathead catfish, hunting trophy whitetail deer and feral hogs, gardening, making wine, or spending time with friends. He is survived by his sons: COL Jimmie Schmidt and wife Lynn, and Roger Schmidt and wife Elisa; daughter, Peggy Schmidt; four grandchildren; one great-grandson; sister, Ann Miculka; brother, David Schmidt; and companion Dorotha Dotson. His wife, Leona Schmidt, brothers: Charlie and Rudolph Schmidt, and sister Dorothy Schmidt preceded him in death.
