



## Agustin N. DeLeon

Agustin was preceded in death by his parents, his wife of 59 years, Minerva, his daughter Diane DeLeon, son Robert DeLeon, granddaughter Lauren DeLeon, and his grandson Brian DeLeon. 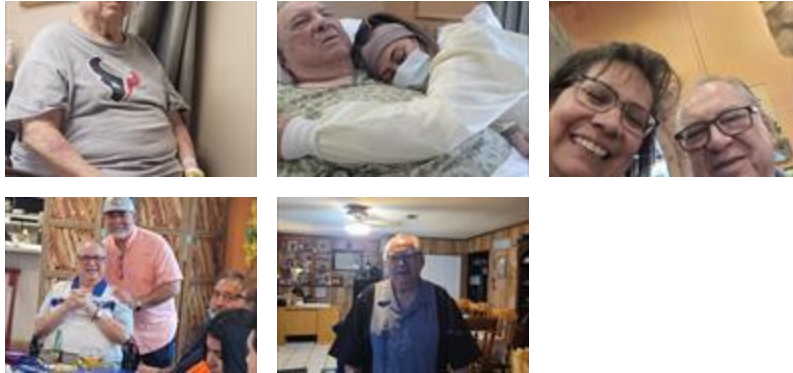
