Albert Arias passed away on Thursday, August 21, 2025. He was born on October

19, 1939, to Gumecindo O. Arias and Adela Delgado. He lived a long, full life of

85, almost 86 years, and spent almost 64 of those years with his high school sweetheart and most adored treasure, his wife, Olivia.

Albert was born and raised in San Antonio, along with his five brothers and two

sisters. After graduating from Fox Technical High School, he proudly served six

years in the U.S. Navy and Naval Reserve from 1957 until 1963. Albert worked as

a Planner at Kelly Air Force Base for more than thirty years, and upon his retirement in 1999, he had accrued almost 35 years of service to this great country.

However, Albert's true passion was always his family. Albert put every husband

and father to shame through his devotion to Olivia, and daughters Loretta and Desiree. Albert was not satisfied with simply loving his family, he truly cherished

them every day.

Albert's performance as a grandfather was truly legendary.

Albert's life embodied the love described by the Apostle Paul in 1 Corinthians 13.

He was patient, kind, not envious, not boastful, not proud, not rude, not self-seeking, not easily angered, and not resentful. He never gave up, never lost

faith, was always hopeful, and his love endured through every circumstance.

Albert was a man of few words, but his loving actions spoke for him. We knew exactly what he believed and precisely how he felt by the way he lived his life for

us.

Albert was always faithful to his Lord and Savior Jesus Christ and tried to live as

He did every day. He leaves behind a rich legacy of love for his family and for others. We can all only aspire to park our trailer in the far corner of his vast lands

in the kingdom of Heaven. We will miss his softness, his kindness, his generosity,

his thoughtfulness, his tender touch and his warm embrace.
