Deacon Albert Hollstein was born February 12, 1917 in Alabama. He peacefully passed on to eternal life with our Lord Jesus Christ on January 23, 2005 after a long illness. His first wife, Marion Green Hollstein, his parents, George and Mamie Hollstein and two brothers preceded him in death.
