Albert Daniel Perez, a beloved brother and uncle, passed away peacefully on November 29th, 2024, at the age of 81. His family and friends will remember him for his patience, kindness, and dedication to those he loved.

Albert was born on July 2, 1943, in San Antonio, TX. He graduated from Burbank High School, where he was voted most Handsome and nicknamed "Killer". He worked with his sister at Joskies, where he was admired by many for his kindness and consideration of others. He joined the Army National Guard. Later, he obtained an associate's degree in criminal justice from San Antonio College, which secured his career up to retirement as a Corporal with Alamo Community College District.

Albert was a devoted Catholic who prayed the rosary every night, as he learned through his elementary days at St Philips of Jesus; it is because of his devotion that he was known as the caretaker for his mother and later his youngest brother. Outside of work, he loved fishing, long walks, bike riding, traveling, and admiring the city through his random Via bus rides. Albert had a passion for history, reading books, Dallas Cowboys & Texas Longhorns, and, of course, Family history, which he shared with his family and friends.

A service for Albert will take place on December 12th at Brookehill Funeral Home, with viewing and rosary from 4:00 to 8:00 PM. St. Leo's Catholic

Church will lead the rosary at 6:00 PM. The following day, December 13th, a Mass will be held at St. Leo's Catholic Church at 10:00 AM, followed by burial at San Jose Burial Park. Family and friends are invited to join in honoring his memory.
