Albin E. Omillian, 88, beloved husband, father, grandfather and great grandfather, passed away on Friday, April 2, 2010 in his home. Al was born on June 15, 1921 in Iron River, MI. Growing up with 10 siblings, he learned at an early age the value of hard work, which he carried with him throughout his life. He served in the Armed Forces, entering the Army Air Corps in 1940. While stationed at Randolph Field in San Antonio, TX, he met Claudine Manning. They married in Waco, TX on Dec. 7, 1941 just hours before the bombing of Pearl Harbor. During World War II and its aftermath, Omillian was stationed in London and participated in the Berlin Airlift. After the war, he and his family travelled all over Europe and Africa during his service in the Air Force. He retired in 1964 at the rank of MSgt. after earning several awards. As a civilian, Al worked at various auto dealerships in San Antonio, retiring at the age of 81. Al loved to tinker around the house and yard, fixing things, painting, building, growing plants and flowers. He continued his "tradition" of working hard even on the day he passed away. He is survived by his wife of 68 years, Claudine Omillian; his daughters and sons-in-law, Rosemary Willbanks, Alene and Don Patton, Nita and Tony Calle, Terri and Randy Evans, Lisa and Travis Tingle; 13 grandchildren and 14 great-grandchildren.
