Alejandro Nicholas Villarreal, SSgt USAF Retired, was called to duty in the service of our Lord on May 18, 2011. Born in Laredo Texas, he attended Martin High School and married his high school sweetheart, Alicia Flores Villarreal. Alejandro served during the Korean War and the Vietnam Conflict. A man of honor and dignity, he continued to serve another 15 years as a volunteer at the Audie L. Murphy VA Hospital.
