Alexander Lara Salazar was born on September 23, 1972 and went to be with the Lord on May 26, 2020. Alexander was passionate about learning and education; he graduated with Honors at McCollum High School for the class of 1990. After High School Alexander was accepted into every IVY league University he applied for. He pursued his education and earned a degree in Molecular Biology at Princeton University graduating class of 1995. Alexander also earned a Master's degree in Science and Biology from the University of Texas in San Antonio and graduated in 2010.

Alexander was not only respected for his passion for knowledge, but for his bravery and his patriotism to his country. While serving in the in the reserves, he received the call of duty for the Mission Operation Enduring Freedom. While serving overseas he was the last of his troop to return home. Alexander was promoted to Captain by the end of his service. He was honorably discharged from the Army on June 10, 2004. While serving he received the honor of the following awards; Army Lapel Button, Army Commendation Medal, Global War on Terrorism Expeditionary Medal, Global War on Terrorism Service Medal, National Defense Service Medal, Armed Forces Reserve Medal W/M Device, as well as the Army Service Ribbon. He was preceded in death by his Father Daniel Gonzalez Salazar. Alexander is survived by his Mother Gloria Lara Salazar; Brother Daniel Lara Salazar JR; Sister Rebecca Ann Lara Salazar; Sister Corinna Lara Vela and husband Reynald Vela Jr.; Nieces, Alexis Gloria Vela and Abigail Grace Vela;

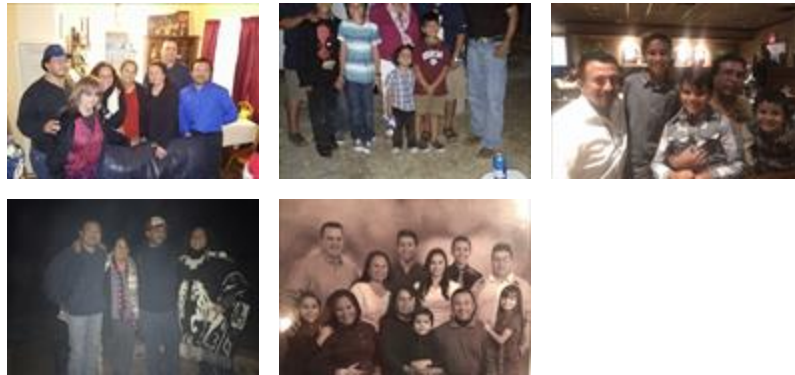
