"AL" Alfred Arthur Brown Sr., age 83 of San Antonio a devoted husband, father, and grandfather passed away peacefully at his residence on 21 June 2014. He was born March 7, 1931 in Flint, Michigan to Winthrop Brown and Anna Willis Brown. TSgt Brown entered military service in 1948 with the Army and served in Japan during the occupation of Japan and the Korean Conflict as an infantryman, in 1954 he transferred to the Air Force and served two tours of duty in the Vietnam Conflict as a combat cameraman/aerial photographer before retiring from the US Air Force in 1973.
