January 29, 1926 - August 24, 2012

Alfred H. Price "Nibs" passed away at the age of 86 on August 24, 2012. He was born in Salinas, California on January 29, 1926. He was preceded in death by his parents, Alfred J. Price and Gladys Price and his brother James Price. He is survived by his loving wife of 64 years Barbara S. Price, his daughter Suzanne P. Treiber, grandson Scott A. Treiber and great-grandson Ethan Blake Treiber. Al spent his entire life dedicated to his country. During his 23 years of active service in the Navy he served in World War II, the Korean and Vietnam wars. He was assigned to Denmark, Da Nang Vietnam, Indonesia, Antarctica, Point Mugu and the Pentagon. While in Antarctica in 1955-1956, Al was assigned to Operation Deep Freeze I. In 1967, Al retired from active service in San Diego, California where he continued his work in Civil Service. After retirement, Al and Barbara moved to San Antonio where he spent several years volunteering his time in the Retired Activities Office at the Naval and Marine Corps Reserve Center as well as the Audie Murphy VA Hospital. Al enjoyed dancing with his wife Barbara at many of the embassy parties they attended. Al was an avid golfer and enjoyed playing several times a week. He was especially proud of his three hole-in-one shots made in his amateur career. He was very athletic, and loved playing tennis and other sports. One of his joys was watching his grandson play baseball and the Helotes team's run to the Little League World Series.
