



## Alice Kathleen Naughton

July 9, 1914 - January 25, 2023

Alice Kathleen Naughton née King born July 9, 1914, entered eternal rest on January 25, 2023. Alice passed away peacefully at home with her daughter Kathleen holding her hand. Only the loving care of Alice's daughters Mary and Elizabeth allowed their beloved mother to live to the fullest every day for well over a century. Her parents George Bernard King/Koenig and Alice Elizabeth McCann preceded her in death. Alice's beloved father was an immigrant who came from Magdeburg, Germany to the United States alone at 16 years of age, landing in Galveston, Texas in 1880 and her mother was born at Fort McKavett in West Texas in 1878. Alice was born in the family home across the street from Hot Wells Resort in San Antonio, Texas. She grew up in San Antonio, attended St. Cecilia's Catholic grade school and graduated from Brackenridge High School, class of 1932. Alice moved to Denver, Colorado in 1933 and graduated from St. Anthony's Hospital School of Nursing on May 12, 1936. Alice met her husband John at a dance at St. Anthony's. John and Alice eloped to Lumberton, New Mexico and were married on January 18, 1936. Alice and John, with their baby John, Jr. "Johnny", moved from Denver to San Antonio, Texas in 1941 after losing their daughter Joan Alice to measles. Their remaining five daughters were all born and raised in San Antonio. Alice and John raised their family with a strong faith in God and sacrificed much to send Johnny and all the girls to her alma mater St. Cecilia's and Johnny to Central Catholic H.S. and the girls to Providence H.S. Alice greatly valued education and pushed all her children to go to college and they

did. In addition to being a wonderful wife and mother, Alice was very active in her community. She volunteered at voting polls, and collected money for the March of Dimes, the American Cancer Society, and the American Heart Association in her neighborhood. Alice was an active member of the Hermann Sons fraternal organization for over 66 years, attending monthly lodge meetings until 2020. She also participated in numerous organizations in her church and the schools her children attended. Besides her parents and daughter Joan, Alice was preceded in death by her beloved husband John Joseph Naughton, her only son John Joseph Naughton, Jr., daughter-in-law Patricia Lamm Naughton, son-in-law Jerry Louis Lecce, and her first grandson, John Joseph Naughton III. Alice is survived by daughters Elizabeth Jean Naughton, Mary Louise Naughton, Kathleen Ann Lecce, Judith Cecilia Costas (Elliott), Susan Alice Andrade, nephews Joe Buesing (Priscilla), John Fournelle (Judy), Joe Fournelle (Joy) and grandchildren, Michael Naughton (Stacey), Joan Dixon (Craig), Christopher Naughton (Lori), Jason Lecce (Kristen), Kevin Lecce (Erin), Benjamin Turner (Lela), Jeffrey Turner, Kelly Andrade, Alfred Andrade III, great grandchildren, Ryan, Cameron, Afton, Ian, Eric, Adam, Jake, Luke, Jackson and Maya. Dearest friends who Alice considered to be like her own daughters Lynne Aranda, Marie Hernandez, Stormy Harvey, Sue Avenell, and Takae Takushi. Alice appreciated her sons-in-law John Turner and Alfred Andrade, Jr. for their continuous support and caring. 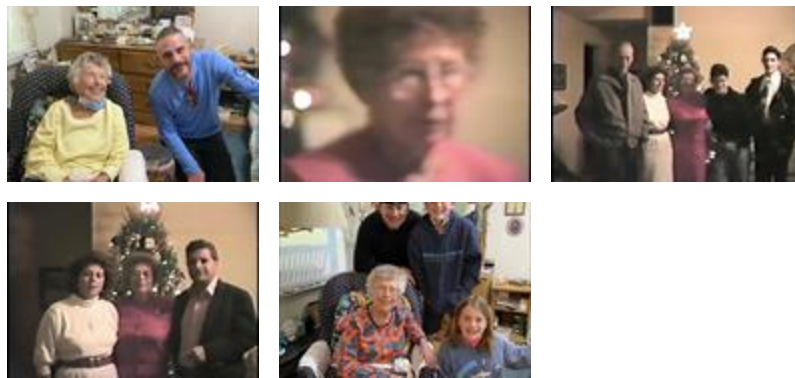

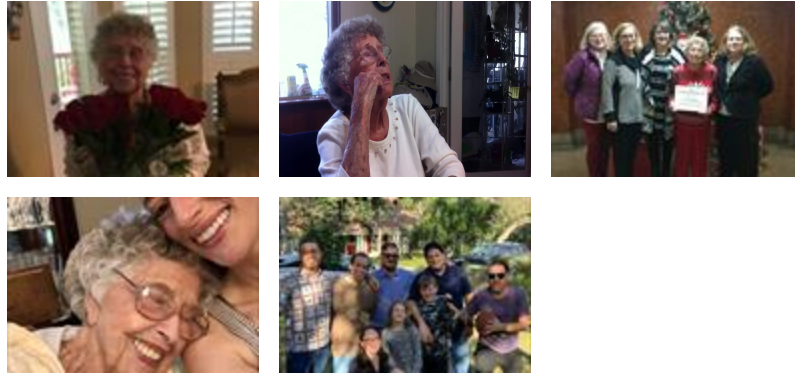
