Reverend Alicia M. Campos entered the loving presence of our Lord and Savior surrounded by her loved ones on January 12, 2024, at the age of 72. She was a woman of profound faith in Christ and genuine love for others. She was a fierce prayer warrior who truly embodied what it means to be a follower of Jesus Christ. Alicia was called to serve others, and she carried out that calling throughout her career as a registered nurse and later as an ordained elder in the United Methodist Church. She will be greatly missed by those who knew and loved her.

Alicia was born on July 27, 1951, in Rio Verde, San Luis Potosi, Mexico. After high school, she went on to earn a degree as a registered nurse specializing in intensive care from the Universidad Autónoma de Tamaulipas. She served as a registered nurse at the Instituto Mexicano del Seguro Social for many years.

In 1975, Alicia married the love of her life, Francisco, and together they raised three children, Karina, Josue, and Daniel. Upon moving to the United States, both Alicia and Francisco served multiple United Methodist congregations in the Rio Grande Conference and Rio Texas Conference with fervor and zeal for the Lord. Alicia is survived by her loving husband of 48 years, Rev. Francisco Campos, and her beloved children, Dr. Karina Gonzalez (Rev.
