Alonso "Al" Reyes Salazar, 84, of Selma, Texas passed away on Sunday, September 14, 2025, in New Braunfels, Texas. Al was born in La Pryor, Texas to Fidel and Isabel Salazar on January 13, 1941. He went to Edgewood High School and graduated in 1960. He worked for Northside Independent School District as an Instructional Assistant for 10 years.
