They returned to San Antonio to await the birth of their first daughter, Rosalinda in 1953. She was shortly followed by Sylvia and a few years later by James. Mother was very proud of all of her children. Family was of the utmost importance to her. If you were accepted as familia you were lucky! She would worry, fuss, advise, and laugh with you a lot! After her divorce, she was hired at Kelly Air Force Base, where she worked for 24 years in various positions before retiring to help care for her mother. She worked part-time for 5 years as a receptionist in a senior program run by Catholic Charities and then AARP. We feel blessed that we had our mom as long as we did. 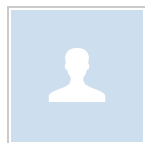

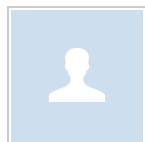
