



Ana Maria Cardoza

July 26, 1961 - April 3, 2023

Ana Maria “Anita” Cardoza fell asleep in death on April 3, 2023, at the age of 61. She was born on July 26, 1961 in San Antonio, Rodeo Durango, Mexico to Mauro and Eloisa (Acevedo) Cardoza. She is preceded in death by her parents. At the young age of 15 she married and made a difficult journey to the United States where she swam across the Rio Grande in search of opportunity. There she settled in the small farming community of Farwell Texas for 32 years where she raised her 3 children as a single mother. In 2008, she journeyed to San Antonio TX to reside near her children and grandchildren. While in San Antonio she discovered her gift of care giving, and spent much of her time

taking care of the elderly in their homes. Many of her patients would comment of her loving touch and kind heart...sweet Ana they would say. If Ana wasn't taking care of others she could be found in her garden, behind a sewing machine, or tending to her flowers.

Ana's love for Jehovah God allowed her to lead her life with love and strength. His love she shared with her children, family, friends, and community. His strength she used to fight her battle with cancer. At the end of her days she was not afraid as her journey would continue towards the Kingdom of Heaven and her hope was to live on earth under the kingdom of God. The last verse in Ana's Bible study journal dated 3/26/2023 was Isaiah 40:26, "Lift up your eyes to heaven and see. Who has created these things? It is the One who brings out their army by number; He calls them all by name. Because of his vast dynamic energy and his awe-inspiring power, Not one of them is missing."

La juventud de Ana comenzó en un pequeño pueblo de México llamado San Antonio, donde vivió una vida humilde y sencilla. Trabajaba en la finca con su padre y siempre fue la mano derecha de su madre. Allí descubrió su amor por la naturaleza y vivir de la tierra. Su madre y su abuela le enseñaron a coser y a su vez la costura se convirtió en una pasión a lo largo de su vida.

A la temprana edad de 15 años se casó e hizo un viaje difícil a los Estados Unidos donde nadó a través del Río Grande en busca de oportunidades. Allí se instaló en la pequeña comunidad agrícola de Farwell Texas durante 32 años donde crió a sus 3 hijos como madre soltera. En 2008 viajó a San Antonio TX para residir cerca de sus hijos y nietos. Mientras estuvo en San Antonio, descubrió su don de cuidar y pasó gran parte de su tiempo cuidando a los ancianos en sus hogares. Muchos de sus pacientes comentarían sobre su toque amoroso y su buen corazón... dulce Ana dirían. Si Ana no estaba cuidando a los demás, se la podía encontrar en su jardín, detrás de una máquina de coser o cuidando sus flores.

El amor de Ana por Jehová Dios le permitió llevar su vida con amor y fortaleza. Su amor lo compartió con sus hijos, familiares, amigos y la comunidad. Su fuerza la usó para pelear su batalla contra el cáncer. Al final de sus días no tuvo miedo pues su camino continuaría hacia el Reino de los Cielos y su esperanza era vivir en la tierra bajo el reino de Dios. El último versículo en el diario de estudio bíblico de Ana fechado el 26/3/2023 fue Isaías 40:26, "Alza tus ojos al cielo y mira. ¿Quién ha creado estas cosas? Es Aquel que saca su ejército por número; Él los llama a todos por su nombre. Debido a su vasta energía dinámica y su impresionante poder, no falta

ninguno de ellos”.

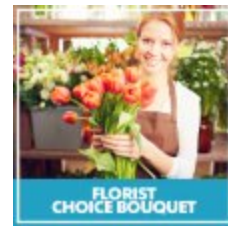
