Andrew O. Bergquist, born June 25, 1921 in San Antonio, Texas to Melvin David and Lucille Louise Lundberg Bergquist, went home to be with his Lord and Savior on February 25, 2010 at the age of 88. Mr. Bergquist was a graduate of St. Mary's University with a degree in Physics. He worked at Petty Geophysical Research Company and later at the School of Aerospace Medicine at Brooks AFB in Biomedical Research. He served his country in the Pacific during W.W. II with the U.S. Coast Guard. A devout Lutheran, he was Baptized and Confirmed at Grace Lutheran Church and later became a member of Mt. Calvary Lutheran Church. He served on the Christian Senior Services Board. He was instrumental in the 1950's and 1960's in bringing Fantasyland at Joskes to life. He was preceded in death by his wife of 58 years, Mary Lois Bergquist in 2007; a brother, Melvin David Bergquist, and sister, Betty Thompson. Survivors include his son, George Andrew Bergquist and wife Mariola; granddaughter, Anna Marie Bergquist; sister in law, Betty Jo Bergquist and numerous nieces and nephews.
