### ANDREW JANOWSKI

February 19, 1926 – October 22, 2018

Andrew Janowski passed away peacefully on Monday, October 22, 2018 at the age of 92 years. He was born on February 19, 1926 in San Antonio, Texas to Mike and Emma Janowski. He was born in his home, built by his papa, on Avondale Ave. Andrew started school at Bonham Elementary and moved to Riverside Park Elementary. From there, Thomas Nelson Page Middle School and then to Brackenridge High School. He worked during his younger years as a soda jerk at the neighborhood pharmacy on S. Presa, where he would meet a young girl, named Tillie. He left high school in April 1944 to join the Army during WWII. He was assigned to the 20th Armored Division and his tour of duty would take him to Europe for combat against the German soldiers. He was awarded the esteemed CIB (Combat Infantry Badge), awarded to infantryman who fought while under fire in ground combat, which he was most proud of, along with various other badges.

He married the love of his life, Tillie Froboese on August 5, 1950. They shared 66 memorable years together until Tillie's death in June 2017, just 2 months shy of what would have been their 67th wedding anniversary. Andrew was a member of St. Margaret Mary Catholic Church and was a USPS letter carrier in the Highland Hills area, better known as Andy the mailman, who whistled

while he worked. He retired from the USPS in 1981 after 32 years of service.

He is survived by his sons Andrew Janowski Jr, Charles Janowski, daughter Cheryl Gray and husband Bobby, granddaughter Lexi Gray. Preceded in death by granddaughter Shawna Gray. He is survived by, sister-in-law Rosemary Gigstead and husband Norman, brother-in-law Joe Howerton, numerous nieces, nephews and friends. His love, hugs and humorous jokes will be missed by all.

Visitation will be held Thursday, November 1, 2018 at Mission Park Funeral Chapels South from 5:00 pm to 9:00 pm with the Holy Rosary to be recited at 7:00 pm. Funeral Services will be held Friday, November 2, 2018 at 1:00 pm followed by military honors and interment in Mission Burial Park South.

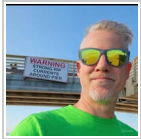
