On her days off from dialysis she would be watching her TikTok videos on her app while sitting on the couch laughing at each one that she found funny, and that laugh was so contagious when I'd hear it in the next

room, that made my heart happy, she enjoyed having her nails done every color and every design she can possibly think of, she would sit on the couch around 12-1pm everyday waiting for her soaps to come on and would watch numerous of her “Days of our lives, Young and the restless, and General Hospital”. Our mom couldn’t really do much but it was the thought that counts and the gestures, kindness and love she had for us, even when we bumped heads, the look in her eyes of love she had for her kids and husband and fear that she didn’t want anything to happen to any us, even when we disappointed her she still loved us no matter what and she showed it in any way possible, and that’s the same love we’re all craving right now and that’s something we’ll never get back, and will forever be a memory in our minds, until we meet again.

Visitation will be on Friday, October 15, 2021 from 5:00 to 8:00 p.m. with a Rosary and Prayer Service to begin at 6:30 p.m. at Mission Park Funeral Chapels South. 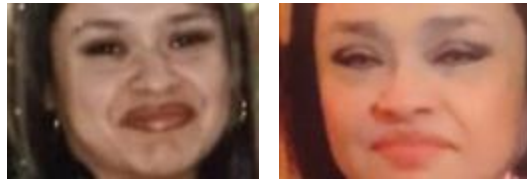
