A loving wife, mother, grandmother and great-grandmother, Angie L. Guzman passed away on July 26, 2018. She spent nearly 20 years driving a school bus for Harlandale ISD.

With an enthusiasm for life, she enjoyed being in the company of family and friends. Quick to offer advice and support anytime, she often was the family baker and was called upon to prepare such favorites as German chocolate, lemon supreme and banana nut cakes or batches of oatmeal and chocolate drop cookies for a gathering. It was common for her to make the simplest of meals like bean and cheese tacos or cheese enchiladas special for the recipient. Holiday meals also were joint efforts and brought together her siblings and their families for years of memories.

Born in Poteet, Texas, on March 24, 1934, to Sophia Ogden and Leonard Lozano, she was the eighth of nine children. She married Salvador H. Guzman in July 1948. Angie chose to stay at home with her children until her son entered the 7th grade, then she began her career with the school district.

Family was extremely important and Angie relished in every minute she had with all generations; she especially loved her great grandchildren, who were very blessed to have the opportunity to brag about their great grandma, and who they lovingly called, Granny. For many decades, Angie and Chave

traveled to visit family in Ohio and all parts of Texas -- where ever their siblings and children and grandchildren moved.
