January 26, 1914 - July 4, 2005

Ann Prather was born January 23, 1914 in Elkhart, Texas to Ella and Monroe Swan. She outlived one brother, Herbert, and three sisters, Eva, Thelma, and Helen. During the Depression she married Gaither Carradine. Their son, Kenneth, was stillborn in 1935. Gaither was killed on a torpedoed troop ship in the Pacific during World War II. A job brought Ann to San Antonio's Fort Sam Houston. She met and married Clyde Prather there in 1947. Their son was born in 1955. In 1982 Ann lost Clyde to cancer. Ann moved to Cleveland, Texas in 2003 where she enjoyed her grandsons, Alan and Michael Prather, and her son and daughter-in-law, Don and Janie Prather. Ann believed that "When God is ready for me, He'll just take me with the snap of a finger." That happened at 9:00 A.M. on July 4, 2005.
