Anne Eibon passed away on August 12th, 2021 of natural causes at the age of 94. Anne was an avid baker, and her legendary chocolate chip cookies and apple pie will be fondly remembered by her family. She was a devout Catholic and attended Cathedral of Christ the King Church in Superior as well as St. Luke's in San Antonio. Anne lived a full and active life well into her 90's and will be greatly missed by her family. Anne is preceded in death by husband Robert Eibon and daughter Sharon Eibon DeMars (husband Doug DeMars).
