She participated in various troops, cookie sales, campouts and Wider Opportunities (special trips to out of state locations). While in India, they rode elephants and stayed at the world Girl Scout center in Sangam. 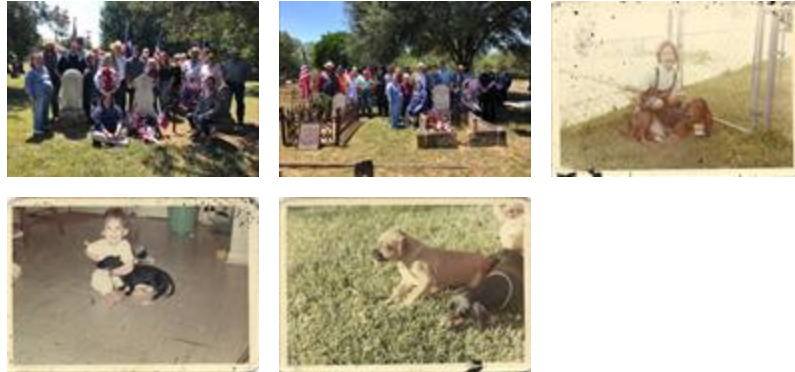
