Anthony J. Buda was born in Brooklyn, New York to Salvatore and Rose Buda on August 29th, 1943, and went to be with the Lord on February 11th, 2025 in San Antonio, Texas. He is preceded in death by his parents and siblings, Salvatore, Frank, and Mary and is survived by his loving wife of 58 years, Diane, and son Randall Buda.

Tony led a life defined by love, resilience, and dedication. Growing up in Brooklyn, he developed a strong sense of family and community that he carried with him throughout his life. Tony worked in Information Technology at Braniff International Airways, Associated Milk Producers Inc. (AMPI), and finished his career at United Services Automobile Association (USAA), leading to a happy retirement.

In his spare time, Tony really enjoyed bowling leagues and tournaments, often times with his son Randall, playing senior softball, and vacation travel. Two of Diane and Tony's favorite trips were a cruise with the Oasis group of the Western Caribbean and a driving trip with Randall up the California Pacific Coast Highway. Tony volunteered time as part of the Knights of Columbus, helped deliver Meals on Wheels to those in need, and helped elderly neighbors with lawn work and other chores as needed.

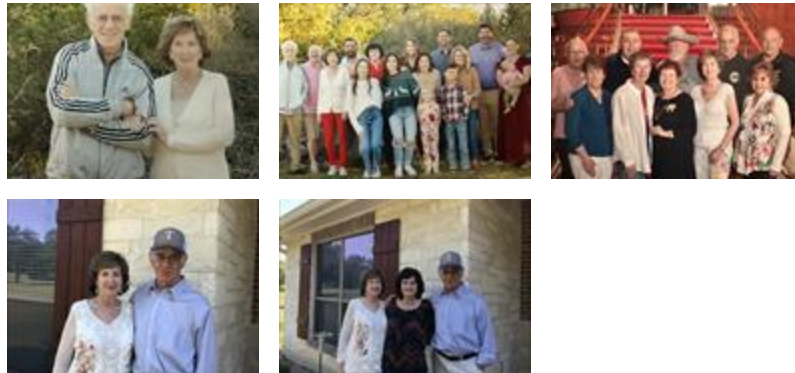

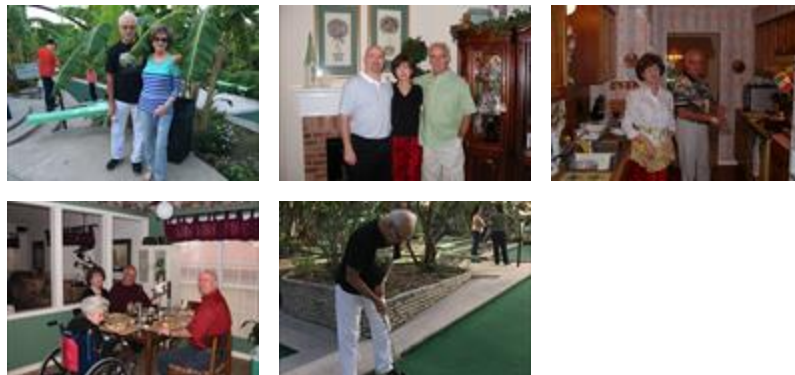
