Colonel Anthony J. DiBaggio, USAF, Retired, passed away on March 5, 2018 at the age of 88. Colonel DiBaggio was a graduate of Ohio University in Athens, Ohio. He entered the United States Air Force at the onset of the Korean conflict and served for some 30 years in various Staff and Command positions worldwide. During his Air Force career, he and his family spent many years at overseas installations. Colonel DiBaggio and first wife Beverly L. DiBaggio chose San Antonio, Texas as their final retirement home.

Colonel DiBaggio retired from the service in 1979 and worked as a banking executive and teacher. He is survived by his wife Sherry A.
