Anthony was a graduate of Thomas Jefferson High School Class of 1975 and served in the United States Navy for 8 years as a Yeoman aboard the USS Waddell DDG-24, San Diego CA and Chase Field NAS, Hangar VT 24, Beeville, TX. He was awarded Sailor of the Month in February 1983. Anthony worked for 29 years as a Letter Carrier with the U.S. Postal Service, Lamar Park Station, Corpus Christi, TX and Lockhill Station, San Antonio, TX. He retired in 2002. Anthony was also a member of the Harlandale Masonic Lodge #1213.

Tony was revered as a father figure offering solace to family members and friends in their time of need, never turning anyone away. When anyone needed help, he was always there.
