Anton (Tony) Gunderson, age 92 passed away Tuesday June 14th, 2022 in San Antonio, Texas. He is preceded in death by his parents, 2 brothers, 2 sisters and wife Muriel Wurst Gunderson. After marrying Muriel and completing his 4 year commitment, Tony returned to NDSU to complete his degree. Following his graduation, Tony began his 33 year sales career at Burroughs Corporation successfully advancing to a regional sales management role in San Antonio.

Tony served on the finance committee at St. Marks Parish, is a life member of the Knights of Columbus, and a member of the Rotary Club.
