She was full of life, full of energy, ready to dance, ready for any kinda party!

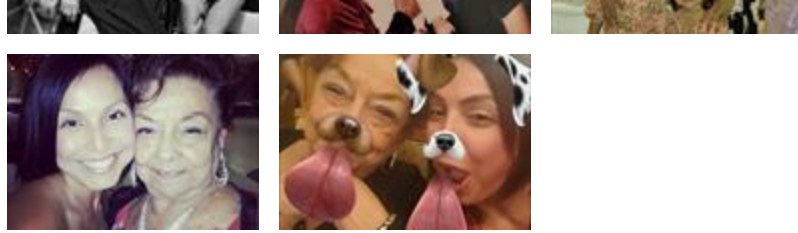
I have so many amazing memories , my greatest memory is my lil ones were able to know and spend time with her and now they have their own memories!!!
