She was just shy of her 75th birthday. A lifelong resident of San Antonio, Tonie was a 1965 Graduate of John F. Kennedy High School and attended San Antonio College.

After taking care of both her parents and brother, she became an exemplary employee of Miller Curtain Company for 10 years.
