June 26, 1948 - February 4, 2018

Antonio (Tony) C. Rodriguez, age 69 years, beloved uncle and brother, was raised in San Antonio and entered rest on February 4, 2018. He attended Edgewood High school and Southwest Texas State University and was a proud Veteran and a Sergeant in the U.S. Army in the Vietnam War having received the Bronze Star Medal with 1 Bronze Oak Leaf Cluster, The Purple Heart, Air Medal, National Defense Service Medal, Vietnam Service Medal with one bronze star, Combat Infantry Badge 1st Award, Republic Of Vietnam Campaign Ribbon W/Device (1960), Sharpshooter Badge With Rifle Bar, Marksman Badge With Auto Rifle Bar, and the Parachutist Badge-Basic. Tony suffered from post-traumatic stress disorder throughout his life. He loved to read and spent most of his time collecting items for his own book. He enjoyed gardening, landscaping and lawn care. His favorite music included Janis Joplin and Bob Dylan.

Mr. Rodriguez is preceded in death by his mother Felipa Cordova Cochran, sisters, Esperanza Campos and Rose Ellen Rodriguez, and a nephew, George Anthony Rodriguez, and is survived by his sisters, Linda Rodriguez Huerta (Alex), Alice Rodriguez, Phyllis Jane Rodriguez Williams (Lewis) and brothers, Armando Rodriguez and Richard Rodriguez.
