Armando Sandoval Arredondo was born on May 6, 1938 in Sonora TX. At the age of 85 he completed his journey on this earth leaving a great legacy that will be difficult to match. He was the best husband, father, grandfather and friend who was beloved and devoted. Armando was preceded in death by his parents Julio and Tomas Arredondo, son Stephen Joseph Arredondo, and brothers Medardo and Emigdio S Arredondo.

He is survived by his wife of 58 years Esperanza B. Arredondo, daughter Adriana Gutierrez, grandson Joshua Gutierrez and numerous nieces and nephews.

Armando was born in Sonora, TX. He was the youngest of three siblings. He was a man who didn't know a stranger. He met his wife in March of 1964 and they married in 1965 at Little Flower Basilica. He always candidly commented that he waited 5 years for her to be born, 20 years to find her and 2 years to hear her say I do. Through the years of their marriage he continued to wait with love and patience for her to put on her makeup and change three or four times to find the perfect dresses.

Armando was one of a million who God created then destroyed the pattern and threw it away. His friends describe him as a kind and generous man who loved to extend a helping hand and share his gifts and knowledge with everyone. Armando knew how to do everything. He was a carpenter, painter, designer, craftsman and did etching on leather and steel. He was an expert marksman in the Army and worked at Kelly AFB for 33+ years as a Quality

Assurance Specialist. He took great pride in all he did. He was a man who has left a great legacy. We are all left with hearts shattered into a million pieces.
