



Arnold D. Grayless

July 30, 1923 - January 1, 2018

Arnold Grayless, 94, died peacefully on January 1, 2018 in Seguin, Texas. He was born on July 31, 1923 in Cleveland, Texas.

Arnold was preceded in death by his beloved wife, Irene. He leaves behind his daughter, Lynda Grayless; daughter Cynthia Ruby and husband Michael Ruby; and his son John Grayless and wife Melissa Grayless. He is survived by eight granddaughters, thirteen great-grandchildren, and two great-great-grandchildren. Arnold was devoted to his family, and especially loved the little ones.

Arnold served as an infantryman in the United States Army during World War II, and continued his service as a paratrooper and infantryman during the Korean Conflict. He was awarded the Purple Heart for an injury received on 7 September 1952 at Kumhwa, Korea. He received service medals including the United Nations Service Medal, Korean Service Medal, Army of Occupation Medal, and National Defense Medal. He also received numerous Letters of Commendation during his service. Following retirement from active military duty, Arnold founded Grayless Mobile Aids, and was given a Presidential Citation for Meritorious Service in 1976 for his service to the disabled.

Arnold received his pilot's license while stationed in Oahu, Hawaii. He loved airplanes and greatly enjoyed flying. He leaves his children with many fond

memories of flying throughout the Hawaiian Islands.

Most importantly, Arnold was a devout Christian. He supported a number of Christian charities, in addition to the church.
