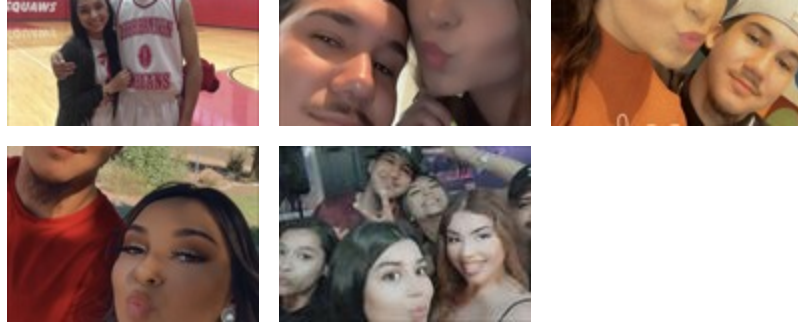
“ Arturo,

“ My sincerest condolences to the Posos family, baby Art and our daughter Selest.

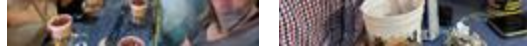
We just keep asking ourselves....Why? Why you? Taken so young too soon. We can't believe that this has happened. Its devastating heartbreaking and seems unreal!
