Arvil Alton "Tim" Holt, LCDR, US Navy, Ret went to be with the Lord on February 1, 2011 in San Antonio, Texas. He was born on January 9, 1935 in Sevierville, Tennessee. Mr. Holt is survived by his loving wife of 51 years, Marie Patricia Holt; daughter, Patricia Tillotson and husband, Steve; son, Mark Holt and wife Donis; sisters, Beulah Jones, Janice Davis and Zula Ridden; grandchildren, Mallory, Andrew, Patrick, Lauren, Nick, Gabrielle; along with numerous nieces and nephews. Tim served his country as a Navy pilot for 21 years. He retired in Kingsville, Texas from active duty in 1976. His many accomplishments included numerous combat missions over Vietnam, delivering the 1000th F4 from the manufacturer to Miramar, Ca. and flying the first F4 non-stop trans-Atlantic flight from Albany, Georgia to Rota, Spain. After retirement, he owned his own roofing company for a few years and then worked at Kleberg County Hospital for 5 years. Tim and his wife Marie moved to San Antonio in 1989.
