DeLaine Sietz, 92, of Fair Oaks Ranch, TX, passed peacefully in the early morning of January 11th 2024. She sure did love her Grandchildren, and her newest addition her great Grandson.

DeLaine had the most beautiful and vibrant soul.

Blessed were those whom were lucky enough to experience her radiate the most incredible light of happiness, while her smile and laugh would gift the most wonderful feeling of warmth and love to all those around her. Those cherished memories and moments will forever live on in our hearts.
