She attended Edgewood High School and then worked at numerous sites such as Lackland Airforce Base, preparing meals in the cafeteria; she worked at SAS, sewing shoes at home. She worked at Levi's jeans. But her PRIDE AND JOY was baking and cake decorating. She worked and retired from HEB grocery in the Bakery department as a Cake Decorator.

There was NEVER an occasion that we did not have a cake at home. All birthdays included delicious home-baked cakes. She also prepared professional wedding and quinceañera cakes. Another pride and joy for my Mom were her two pecan trees. She planted them over 60 years in the backyard of her childhood home, and to this date, the pecan trees are still in her home, providing the most beautiful shade and a bounty of pecans!

Ms. Limón is preceded in death by her parents, José and Marcelina Martinez, and siblings, Eva Ramirez, Rudy Martinez, and Raquel Herrera. She is survived by her beloved husband of 55 years, Nazario Limón; her beloved children, Robert Limón (Angie Limón), Paul A. 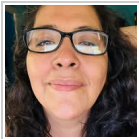
