



Barbara Ann Mitchell

June 8, 1933 - July 6, 2021

Barbara Ann Mitchell died Tuesday July 6, 2021 at the age of 88. Born June 8, 1933 in Rochester, Indiana, and was the only child of Albert and Marie Ackermann. She graduated in June 1951 from La Feria High School in La Feria TX. She served in the Air Force from 1951 to 1952 and married Paul Alexander Mitchell on March 1st, 1952 at Montgomery Air Force Base in Montgomery, AL. While moving due to her husband's employment, she was employed by the U.S. Air Force in Turkey and Public Health Service in Kotzebue, Alaska. In 1962, she was employed by the Social Security Administration. She worked in Social Security District Offices in Flint, Michigan; Key West, Florida; Odessa, Texas; and the Social Security Program Service Center in Kansas City, Missouri as a supervisor. In 1988, she transferred to the Social Security District Office in Austin, Texas, where she retired in 1997 after 36 years of Federal Service. Mrs. Mitchell and her husband Paul, moved to San Antonio in 1998 to be near their children and grandchildren. Mrs. Mitchell is survived by her husband of 69 years and their children, Pamela Joaquine Mays (George) and Donald Andrew Mitchell (Cynthia). Grandchildren Kenneth Rockwell (Marna), Victoria Mays and David Mitchell and Great Grandchildren Emma Rockwell, Paige Rockwell, Alexis Mitchell, Haley Mitchell, Lillie Mitchell and Paul Mitchell. She was preceded in death by grandson Joseph Mitchell (survived by wife Rochelle). She will also be missed by several nieces and nephews.
