November 4, 1923 - November 24, 2005

Lt. Col. Bernard Elliott passed away on November 24, 2005. During his 25 year career in the Air Force he flew 30 missions over Berlin during WWII at the age of 18. He also received the Air Force Commendation Medal and in 1953 he parachuted out of a burning plane over Randolph Air Force Base and was one of four survivors. Bernard is preceded in death by his loving wife Josephine C. Elliott. He is survived by his son, Curtis Elliott and wife Belinda; brother, Robert Elliott and wife Betty; grandson, Jason Elliott.
