



## Bertha T. Anske

June 19, 1914 - January 21, 2007

Born June 19, 1914, Bertha Turner was one of four sisters and a brother who were orphaned at an early age. She was raised by family members across Mississippi and spent her teenage and early adult years in Belzoni, MS. Before WWII, she met Ralph Anske from Altoona, Pennsylvania, who was in the

Army Air Corps. They married in 1942. Colonel Anske finished his military career at Kelly AFB in 1957; he and Bertha remained in San Antonio for the rest of their lives.

They were founding members of Oak Hills Presbyterian Church, and Bertha was

very active in volunteer work there, finally ceasing weekly service about four years ago. Her husband Ralph died in November, 1981. She resided at Morningside Manor. They are survived by their son, Ralph and his wife, Kay, who are Foreign Service Officers.
