Beth Mildred Brady Forsen, a life-long resident of the Southside of San Antonio, entered eternal peace on Saturday, December 12, 2020. 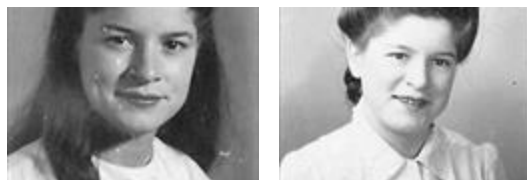
