



## Betty Kuen Wong

July 17, 1934 - May 16, 2021

Betty Kuen (Wu) Wong passed peacefully on May 16, 2021.

Betty was born July 17, 1934 in Shui Gao Lai village of China, to Fred and Kan Jean Wu. She immigrated to San Antonio, Texas at the age of 13. In 1956, she met her husband, Hong Sun “Sunny” Wong, at a Chinese New Year’s celebration and they were happily married within a year. They were the proud parents to their three children, Scott, Sarah, and Stanley. For over 30 years, she and her family were familiar faces to many in the community after opening their family-owned business, El Camino Super Market, in 1968. The family eventually built a new location on Palo Alto Road and expanded to become El Camino Food Center. Through their generosity, Betty and Sunny were able to assist the community in many ways. Upon her arrival to Texas, Betty became involved in the community as an active member of the First Chinese Baptist Church of San Antonio which her father helped found in 1923. She continued to attend throughout her life and supported the church and Chinese community as well. She was also an avid gardener and a devoted San Antonio Spurs fan.

Betty is now reunited with her husband, Sunny, son, Stanley, parents, Fred and Kan Jean, brother, Harry, and his wife, Patty Wu.

She will be deeply missed and remembered by her children Scott (Angela) and Sarah (Sing) Lim; her grandchildren Samantha and Alexander Wong and

Jared, Jordan, Jonathan and Jason Lim and other family and friends. The family would like to especially thank the WellMed staff, Stone Oak Methodist Hospital nurses and Suncrest Hospice for the care and kindness they provided.

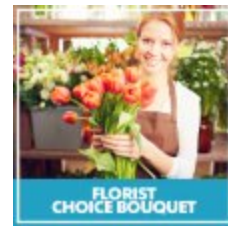
