



## Beverly Jo Ferguson Carter

August 17, 1927 - September 25, 2024

In the early hours of September 25th, Beverly Jo Carter went to be with our Lord. She was born in Shreveport LA on August 17, 1927 to Largent L. Ferguson and Lura E. Baughman.

The family moved to Plainview TX then on to San Antonio after the death of her mother at an early age. Beverly was in the Cadet Corps at Jefferson High School where she graduated in the class of 1944. In her early 20's, she worked with the entertainment troupe at Lackland Air Force Base and at the USO. It was at the USO where one night she claimed "the cutest boy in the room." She went on to marry that soldier on August 6, 1949. Seven days after being discharged, Jimmy and Bev became Mr. and Mrs. James Anthony Carter.

For a number of years, Beverly had the coolest job at both Joske's and Wolff & Marx. She worked in the record department and was in the first batch of employees to be hired at North Star Mall. In the early 60's, her volunteer job at St. Anthony de Padua Catholic Church became permanent employment and she worked there as the church secretary for another 40 years.

It was during this time that Beverly discovered a love for oil painting. This love ignited her artistic passion. After retiring, she both attended and taught classes and workshops in watercolor, card making, stamping, paper making,

marbling, quilling, doll making, book making, origami, calligraphy and several other art creations that are hard to describe.

Beverly is preceded in death by her parents Largent and Lura Ferguson, her brother Bob Ferguson and her husband Jim Carter.
