



## Bill Oglesby

February 17, 1923 - May 12, 2011

### OGLESBY

Bill Oglesby, born February 17, 1923 died May 12, 2011. Bill went to North Texas University on a football scholarship until joining the Marine Corps and serving almost four years in World War II. After completing two degrees at North Texas and marrying B.J. McCullar, he was recalled by the Marines for the Korean conflict. Returning to his coaching career, he moved to Lubbock where they won two state football titles. Then he moved on to the housing industry and became a mortgage banker for thirty years. Being a strong Republican, Bill served as precinct chairman and election judge. He was a Charismatic Christian, serving as usher and deacon - teaching Bible studies and leading prayer groups. After 49 years in Lubbock, he and B.J. moved to San Antonio ten years ago to be with family. He was preceded in death by daughters, Lynn Oglesby and Jan Martin. He is survived by his wife of 64 years, B.J. and daughters, Pam Oglesby and Fran Williams and husband, Mike; granddaughters, Amanda Adams, Hannah Oglesby, and Chrissy Williams and 2 great-grandchildren.
