Billie Jessica King born December 27, 1926 in Vivian, LA was called home to be with the Lord January 10, 2008 at the age 81. She is survived by her husband, Rev. Lawrence King and three sons, Larry King of Boerne, TX, Timothy King of Sugarland, TX and Nathan King of Sealy, TX. She is further survived by two brothers, Rev. H. L. Stevens and Rev. L.L. Stevens, nine grandchildren, twelve great-grandchildren, many nieces, nephews and friends. Billie King was a graduate of the first class "The Pioneer Class" in the early to mid 40's from International Bible College of San Antonio. Later, she became an instructor for the school. There she met and married Rev. Lawrence E. King, Sr. and was married for almost 60 years. She and her husband came back to San Antonio after pastoring in Colfax, LA in 1955. At that time, they became the pastors of First United Pentecostal Church originally located at the corner of S. Presa and Carolina Street near downtown and later built the church located at 350 Utopia. In 1990, they retired from their pastoral duties from their church but still remained as members.
